- Meet:** •2010 UIL Region VII Class 4A and Under Swimming and Diving Championships
- Dates:** •February 11, 12 and 13, 2010
•Diving only on Thursday, February 11th
•Swimming Friday *and* Saturday.
- Venue:** •Josh Davis Natatorium
•Blossom Athletic Center (North East Stadium)
•Jones-Maltsberger Road at Starcrest / Bitters
•San Antonio, TX 78217
•210-491-6132
- Facility:** •Eight FINA-width (2.75-meters) lanes
•0.75-meter buffers outside lanes one and eight
•2.25-meter minimum depth
•All automatic starting and timing
•Full, real-time scoreboard with heat and event display
•Heat and event board operates in the adjacent Walker warm-up / cool down pool (16 lanes)
•Off-deck seating for 1500
•Spectators are not permitted on deck.
•Concessions and swim shop in the lobby
- Rules:** •The 2009 - 2010 National Federation Swimming, Diving, and Water polo Rules will govern this meet
•The USA Swimming Whistle Start Procedure will be in use at this meet
- Cell phone restrictions:** •The presence and / or use of cell phones, and any other equipment capable of producing photographic or video images, in locker rooms is strictly and specifically prohibited at all times.
•There are no exceptions to this prohibition.
•Violators are subject to disqualification from the meet and disbarment from the facility.
- Format:** •Championship with two heats, Championship and Consolation advancing to finals
•Nominal 45 seconds between races in preliminaries
•Fifteen minute break after the 50-yard freestyle in preliminaries
•Nominal 90 seconds between races in finals
•Fifteen minute break after the men's 50-yard freestyle in finals
- National Time**
- Verification:** •This meet has been approved by USA Swimming for NTV purposes
•In order for a time from a high school championship or season culminating meet to be entered into the USA Swimming (USA-S) National SWIMS Database, the athlete must be currently registered with USA-S – *AND* – the athlete's USA Swimming ID Number must be accurately entered into the Meet Manager Database
•No further action by either the coach or the athlete is necessary
•ALL swims involving the backstroke will be observed by USA Swimming Certified Officials and exceptions to the technical rules will be noted to the NTV Officer on deck
- Entry Restrictions:** •Each swimmer may enter four events, no more than two of which may be individual events
•No school may enter more than four swimmers in any single individual event
•Each school is limited to one relay team per relay event

Swim suit

- Restrictions:**
- Only one suit is permitted during competition
 - The suits must:
 - Be of one piece
 - Be constructed of woven / knit material
 - Be 100% permeable to air and water
 - Not aid buoyancy
 - Not have fastening system other than waist ties, casings, ribbing or elastic (no zippers)
 - Not extend beyond the shoulders or below the top of the kneecap and not cover the neck for women
 - Not extend above the waist or below the top of the kneecap for men
 - Swimmers found in violation of these restrictions will be banned from further competition until the violation has been remedied

Entry

- Deadline:** • 12-noon, Tuesday, February 2, 2010 - No exceptions!

Entry

- Procedures**
- Entries must be submitted by Hy-Tek Commlink disk or file
 - Hard copy must accompany
 - Please format disks before utilizing for entries
 - Each entry must include the swimmer's full name, swimmers school affiliation/grade, and a seedtime
 - Entries received without a seedtime will be rejected
 - Submit entries to the Meet Director (see below)
 - Entries will not be accepted via FAX.

Relays:

- Eight (8) individuals may be designated on back of the relay card, but it will not count as an event unless that individual actually competes on the relay team.
- Only the four (4) swimmers declared on the front of the relay card are permitted to report to the blocks and compete.
- If the swimmers are to be correctly noted in the Final Results, the order of swimming must also be specified.
- Relay cards for the 200-yard Medley Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer not later than the beginning of the coaches' meeting. Penalty 1. under Rule 3.2.1 will apply.
- Relay cards for the 200-yard Free Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer not later than the start of the men's 500-yard freestyle. . Penalty 1. under Rule 3.2.1 will apply.
- Relay cards for the 400-yard Free Relay must be turned in to the Official Scorer not later than the start of the men's 100-yard backstroke. Penalty 1. under Rule 3.2.1 will apply.
- Once relay cards have been turned in to the Official Scorer, no changes will be permitted and post-meet corrections cannot be made.

Entry

- Fees:**
- \$12.00 per athlete
 - All entry fees must be paid prior to the start of the meet
 - If, for any reason, payment of the fees is to be delayed, a School District Purchase Order reflecting the proper amount and payable to Palo Alto College will be acceptable
 - Checks payable to: **NEISD**

Scratch

- Rules:**
- Championship format
 - Scratches are not permitted
 - Swimmers who fail to appear for any competition which they have entered or have qualified for, will be disqualified from further competition
 - Previous performances will not be nullified
 - Failures to compete by reason of illness or injury are excepted, as are alternates
 - An individual swimmer or relay team may withdraw from competition without penalty in any given event by declaring a false start

- Alternates:**
- Swimmers who qualify as alternates for final events and wish to compete should no shows occur, must be within an area designated by the Meet Referee and be immediately available

- Immediately is defined as being properly attired, on the block and ready to swim within 30 seconds of being called

Diving:

- National Federation Rules will apply
- 11-dive format
- 1-meter board only
- Five (5) voluntary dives and six (6) optional dives must be performed
- All divers must be entered with their high school team via Hy-Tek Commlink
- Completed dive sheets must be sent to the Diving Referee by the Entry Deadline
- All corrections / revisions must be in the hands of the Diving Referee not later than one hour prior to the scheduled start of competition
- Preliminaries and Finals will be conducted during the same session
- There will be no diving during the swimming finals.
